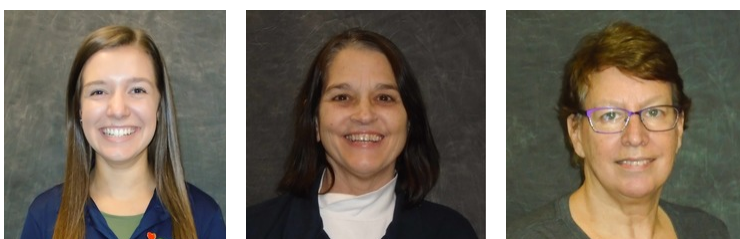




End of Life Certification
